What are the benefits of chapter membership?

Membership Categories

Regular Member: Any independent special district as defined in California Government Code §56044, or any district that is eligible for membership in CSDA, with territory in Santa Barbara County. Concurrent membership in CSDA is encouraged but not required. Regular members have voting privileges.

Associate Member: Any person or organization that provides services to special districts or has evidenced interest in the purpose of the Chapter may become an associate member upon approval of Chapter membership and payment of dues. Associate members have no voting privileges.

Annual Dues

Regular members with annual budgets of more than \$1 million - \$300

Regular members with annual budgets less than \$1 million - \$150

Associate members - \$50
